Now that the costumes are gone, the staff have been working very hard on so many fun things for November; all to say Thank you for being a Gale Credit Union Member!



A broken record of FRAUD

Will it ever end? *No.* How can we better help Members stay protected from all the scams? *Education and a Free Advice Service!*

When a scam hits again, we try to inform Members via this Newsletter and email at times. We also encourage Members to call us when something does not seem right.

<u>Court Recording:</u> We are not aware of any service where you legitimately need to pay money for a copy of a Deed, a Mortgage, or anything. SCAM.

<u>Phishing</u>: Call us about your Mortgage: If it is not correspondence with Gale CU or Servion official letterhead, likely a phishing scam—do not call. And, we already have your information so why do we need to ask for it again? SCAM.

<u>Girl/Boyfriend:</u> If you have not met her/him in person, then they DO NOT need you to send them money! There is NO reason to send these scammers money. Why would you send a "new friend" money if you have not met? SCAM!

<u>USPS or UPS or FedEx Address</u>: None of these, to our knowledge, sends you a text stating...we can't find you...update your address. That is a Phishing SCAM! <u>New Account</u>: If anyone tells you to open a new account at any institution so you can cash or deposit a check, it is a SCAM.

<u>Deposit Check—Send Back Money:</u> Why would anyone you do not know send you a check for too much money and trust you to send some back? SCAM!
